INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

On manufactured systems with Serial Numbers 2522 and back, it will be necessary to return your main ladder for calibration. Contact distributor or sales representative for details. On systems with Serial Numbers 2523 and up, there are two (2) set screw holes on one (1) end of each of the outside rails. Use this end for installation.

Step 1

Slide tape out of tape guide on the main ladder. (See Figure 1.)



Step 2

Remove tape guide. Check inside of the main ladder on tape guide side for any burrs. If any, remove. This will help tape to slide without interference. (See Figure 2.)



Step 3

Insert connecting bars into ladder extension rails and install the four flat head (connecting bar) screws but do not tighten at this time. (See Figure 3.)

IMPORTANT:

- Connecting bars are shipped inside of ladder extension rails. They must be removed and their direction reversed prior to reinsertion in ladder extension rails.
- 2. The connecting bar with cutout for tape goes on tape guide side.
- 3. Do not loosen ladder extension crossbar screws.



Step 4

Slide the ladder extension into the end of the main ladder. (See Figure 4.)



Step 5

Tighten the four flat head (connecting bar) screws on the ladder extension.




Step 6

Install and tighten four (4) set screws on the main ladder. (See Figure 5.)

Step 7

Install tape guide on the end of the ladder extension. Slide the tape back into place. (See Figure 6.)
